

Firmware 19.0.3 for Hasselblad HC and HCD Lenses

The 19.0.3 release adds AF support for additional HC/HCD Lenses when using the XH Lens Adapter with the X1D Camera. Now, all HC/HCD Lenses except the HC120 Macro can be used with AF. It also addresses a problem with some lenses that could hit the end stops too hard. This firmware should be used for all HC/HCD lenses.

Please note that the HC/HCD Lens **must have firmware 18.0.0 or later**. Lenses with older firmware have hardware that cannot be updated with this firmware. They can only be used with manual focus on the X1D.

New feature:

- AF when using the HC/HCD on the X1D camera for the following Hasselblad H System lenses:

HCD24, HC150, HC150N, HC210, HC300, HCD35-90 and HC50-110

Bug fix:

- Reduces the risk for unnecessary mechanical wear to the gears inside the lens, that previously could happen with some lenses.

Update procedure

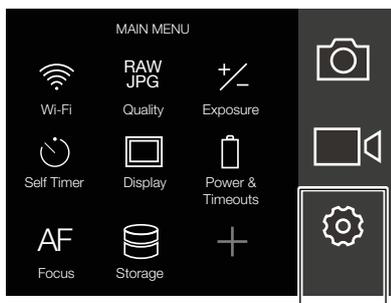
Make sure that you use a fully charged battery on the camera. A charge level of 50% or more is required. Please note that the update procedure normally takes about 2-4 minutes.

Attach the HC/HCD Lens to be updated to the X1D, using the XH Lens Adapter.

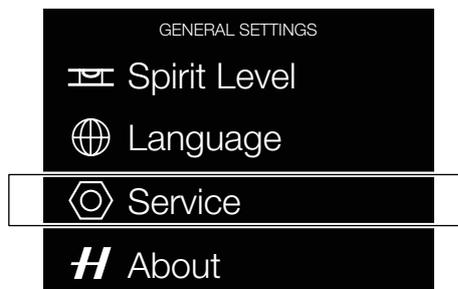
IMPORTANT NOTE:

- After the update, you must wait until the message “Update Finished” is shown. Then remove and reinsert the battery.

Copy the downloaded file (HC-Lens_v19_0_3.cim) to the SD card and insert it into the camera. Then follow the procedure below:



1: Select the “General Settings Menu” from the main menu.



2: Select “Service”



3: Click “Check for Update” and select the file “HC-Lens_v19_0_3.cim” from the list. Finally click “Update”.
